

Reading

Reading will take place daily. Four sessions a week will be dedicated to reading a focus paragraph developing our fluency (reading aloud with automaticity) and answering comprehension questions. One session a week will aim to develop a real love of reading through a variety of activities. Please read at home daily.

Writing

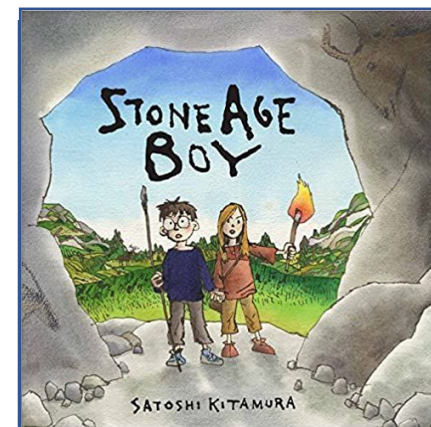
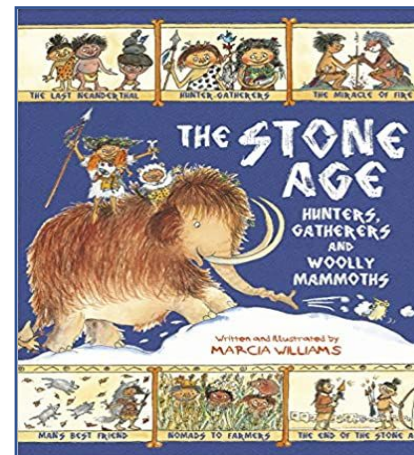
Our Key texts will become the models for looking at instructions, narrative and poetry styles of writing. We will look at structures authors use and build up a bank of vocabulary and phrases to use in our own writing. Our lessons will include a variety of drama and oracy skills to immerse the children in the text.

Mathematics

In Maths, we will be revisiting prior learning in place value and will be understanding which each digit represents in a number, including using 2 digit and 3 digit numbers. We will also be learning how to add and subtract using a range of resources and using the column method. We will also learn how to exchange. Towards the end of Term 2, we will be learning how to multiply and divide, and will be learning our 3 and 4 times tables.

Science

In Science this term we will be looking at how the human body functions. This will include knowledge and understanding of the muscular system, the skeleton, the nervous system, nutrition and the digestive system.



History

We are travelling back in time and learning all about the Stone Age! We will be understanding all of the different periods of time and how their lives compared and differed to ours today.

Geography

In Geography, we will be learning about maps, compasses and their symbols. We will use our field skills to create our own maps with symbols. We will be looking at human and physical features including making comparisons between London and San Francisco.

Art & DT

In Art, we will be developing our drawing skills. Using the art of line to create our own versions of 'The Wave' by Hokusai. In DT, we will learn how to create an electrical circuit which will then use to power a torch. We will be designing and creating our own Stone Age torches.

PE

Indoor PE – This term we will be learning about Gymnastics.

Outdoor PE – The Brighton and Hove Coaches will be teaching the children ball skills and other skills related to a variety of sports.

MFL

We will revise the KS1 french vocabulary. We will be finding out who speaks French around the world. The children will learn how to use french greetings in conversations. If you would like to practice at home download Duolingo for tailor made lessons.

PSHE & Computing

We will setting class expectations and considering our goals for the year. We will look at how we can develop ourselves as learners. In computing we will look at the Internet, how computers connect together, as well as programming multiple variables and sensors on a robot.

RE

This term we will be learning about Diwali and Hinduism. We will be learning about how they celebrate. We will also be exploring the sense of belonging that comes with the following of this specific religion.

Music

This year we will be learning how to play the recorder with a Specialist Teacher. There will be a performance at the end of the year to demonstrate all that we have learnt.
